Notification of Proposed Annexation by the City of San Marcos

Dear Public Entity Representative:

Under Local Government Code Chapter 43, cities are required to notify certain public entities of all proposed annexations. The San Marcos City Council is considering the following annexations that may affect your jurisdiction:

Annexation of a 1.11 acre +/- acre tract of land out of the T.H.W. Forsyth Survey, Abstract No. 173 in Hays County, Texas, generally located on 1850 Old Ranch Road 12 approximately 1,900 feet west of the intersection of Craddock Avenue and Old Ranch Road 12.

All annexations are subject to notification, public hearings, and vote by City Council. The annexation schedule is as follows:

Ordinance 1st Reading (Public Hearing): March 1, 2022 at 6pm, City Council Chambers, City Hall, 630 E Hopkins St, San Marcos. (This hearing is a hybrid of virtual and in-person meeting.)

Ordinance 2nd Reading: March 23, 2021 at 6pm, (Hybrid of virtual and in-person meeting)

The City Council of the City of San Marcos, Texas, will hold a public hearing via hybrid meeting at **6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 1, 2022**, to consider the above request. 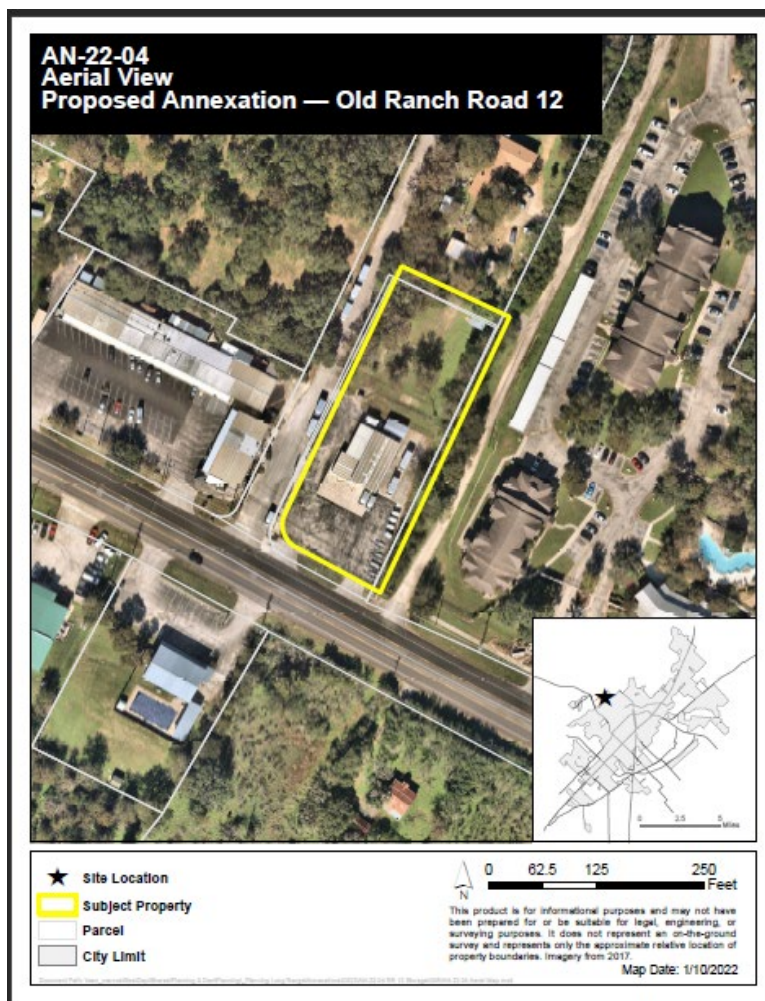
