

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-105R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS AUTHORIZING A REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR UP TO \$130,000.00 FOR THE SAN MARCOS REGIONAL AIRPORT CONTROL TOWER IMPROVEMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACTS AND AGREEMENTS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN SUCH REIMBURSEMENT AND TO EXECUTE A DESIGNATION OF SPONSOR'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos intends to make certain improvements to the San Marcos Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, the general descriptions of the projects are described as: Airport Control Tower Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos intends to request financial assistance from the Texas Department of Transportation for these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Airport Control Tower Improvements is estimated not to exceed \$130,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the federal share of the costs are not to exceed \$130,000.00 which is the amount for which the City Council of the City of San Marcos now desires to seek reimbursement for the Above Ground Fuel Storage Facility Fuel Project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

PART 1. A request for reimbursement from the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) for the Airport Control Tower Improvements for the San Marcos Regional Airport in the estimated amount of \$130,000.00 is hereby authorized.

PART 2. The City of San Marcos authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, to execute all contracts and agreements with TXDOT as necessary to seek the reimbursement from TXDOT and to execute the attached Designation of Sponsor's Authorized Representative designating Shaun Condor, P.E. – Director of Engineering as the City of San Marcos authorized representative for the project who has the authority to make approvals and disapprovals as required for the project on behalf of the City of San Marcos.

PART 3. City staff is authorized to amend this resolution as necessary to conform to the formatting or other requirements required by TXDOT provided the amendment does not change the project, the funding amount or the amount of any City matching funds.

PART 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
