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## **Overview of the Economy**



- The Federal Open Market Committee increased interest rates 0.25% to a target range of 5.25% to 5.50% in July
- The Committee is trying to reduce inflation to a rate of 2 percent over time
- Inflation in September 2023
  - Consumer Price Index: 3.7%, less food and energy: 4.1%
- Unemployment as of September 2023 (Unadjusted)
  - San Marcos: 3.5%
  - Texas: 4.1%
  - US: 3.6%
