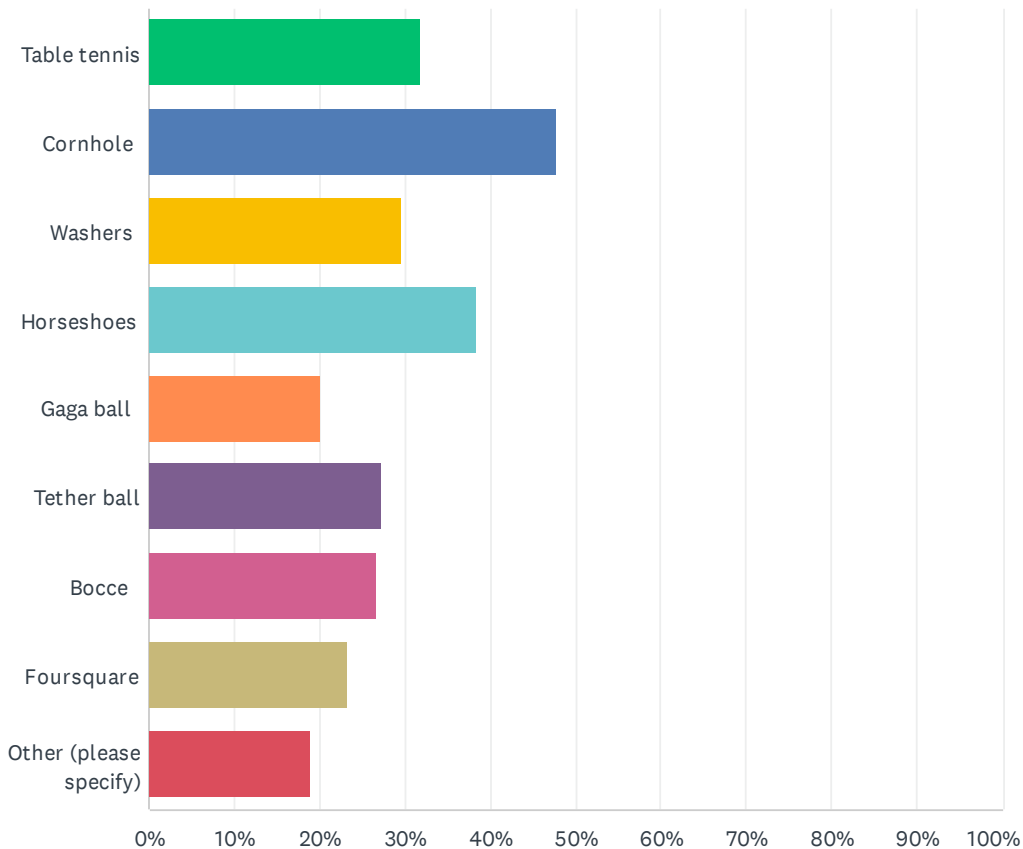

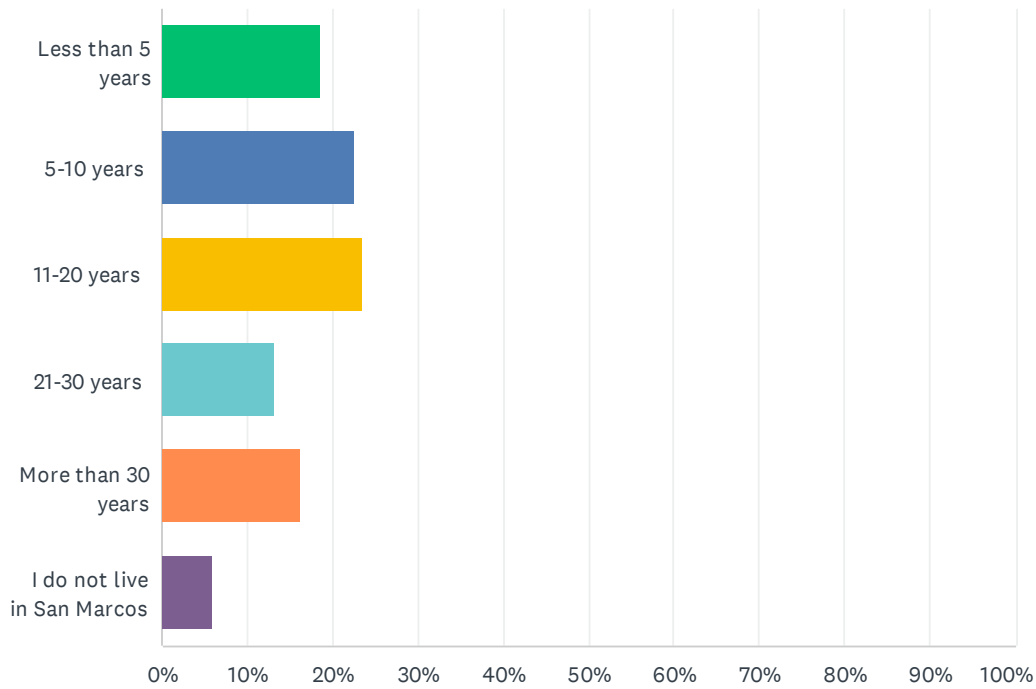

Q9 How long have you lived in San Marcos?

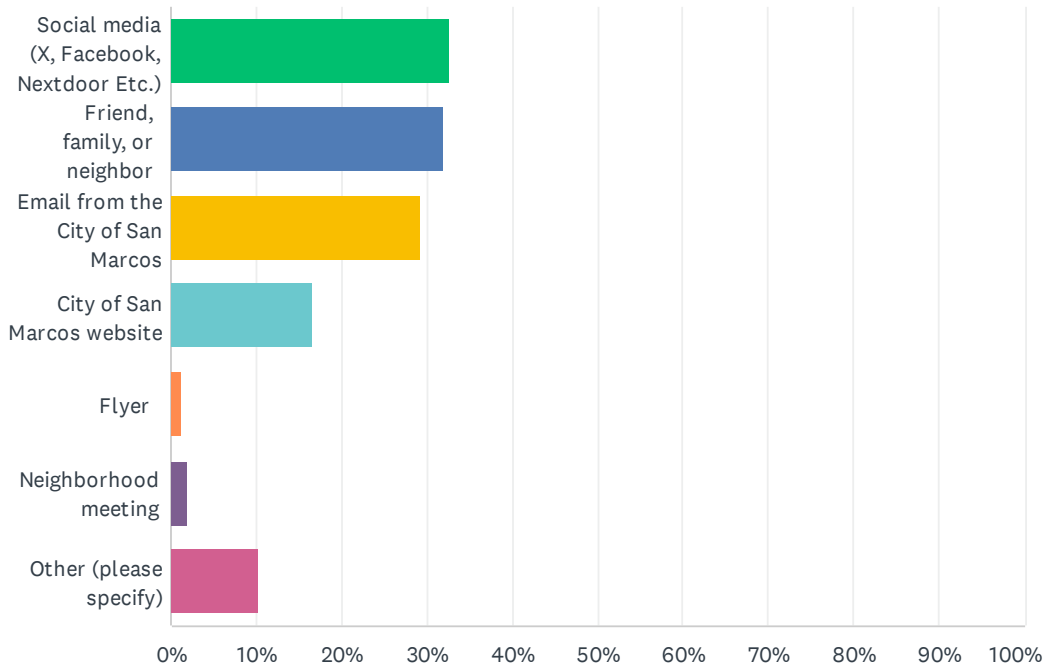

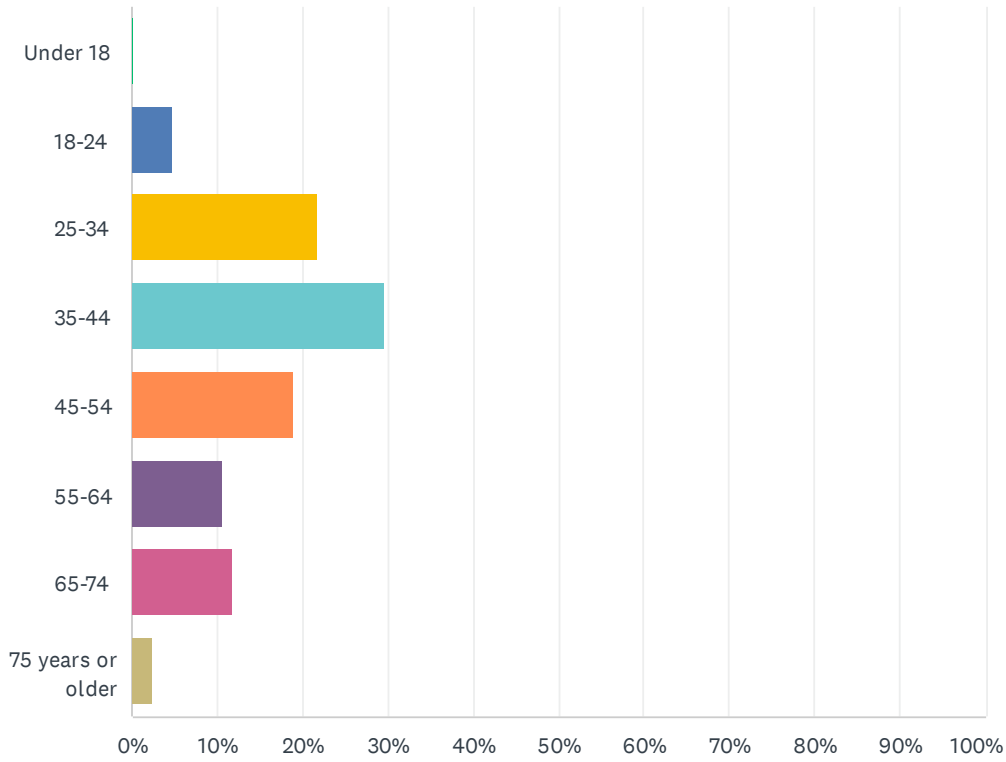

Q11 In which category is your age?

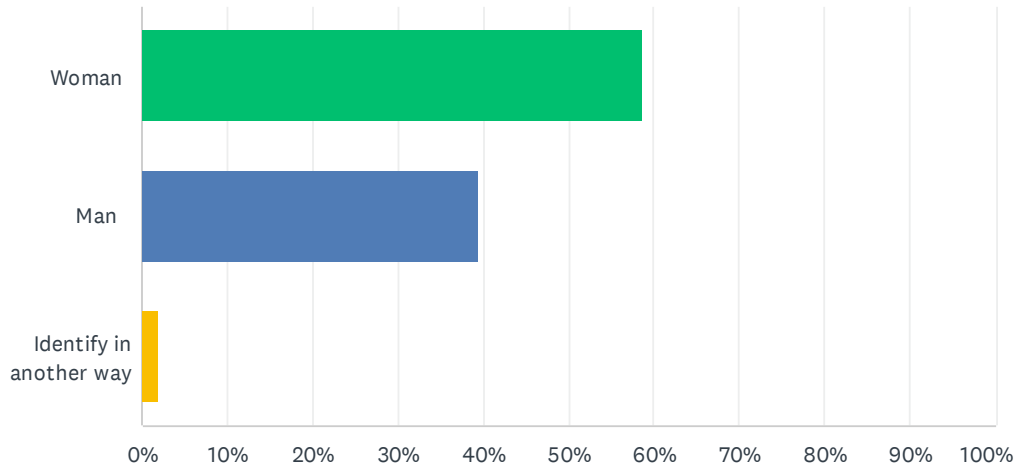

Q12 What is your gender?

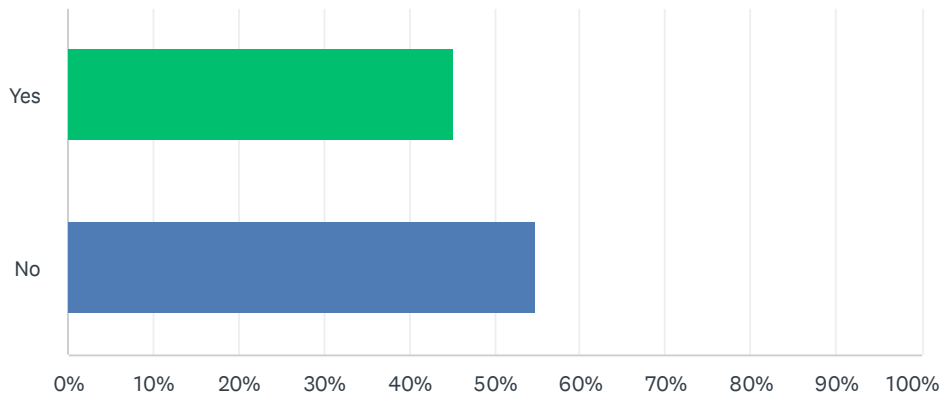

Q13 Do any children 17 or under live in your household?

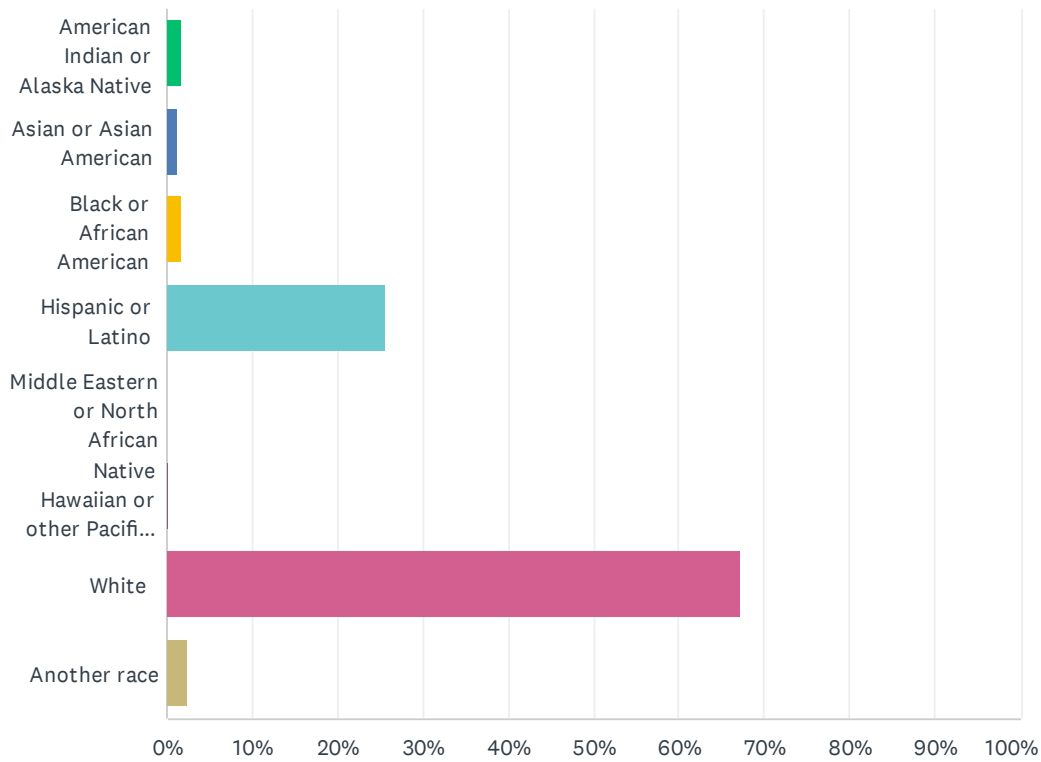
