


NEIGHBORHOOD SURVEY

We understand that: (i) if this area is designated, certain restrictions will be placed upon on street parking within the area; (ii) residents and/or residential property owners of the area will be entitled to obtain a limited number of parking permits exempting their vehicles from such parking restrictions, but if a resident and/or property owner owns a vehicle without having a permit displayed, that vehicle will be subject to the parking restrictions; (iii) parking permits will be issued for a term of one year and require replacement each year; (iv) the cost of the annual parking permits will be paid by the residents and/or property owners. This restriction will be valid for a minimum of one year.
