**RENOTICE of Proposed Annexation by the City of San Marcos – AN-24-06 (County Right-of-Way Annexation)**

Dear Public Entity Representative:

Under Local Government Code Chapter 43, cities are required to notify certain public entities of all proposed annexations. The San Marcos City Council is considering the following annexations that may affect your jurisdiction:

**Annexation of 30.69 +/- acres, at the request of the City and Hays County, of the following road rights-of-way located in Hays County, Texas; Centerpoint Road as it runs from Hunter Road to Interstate Highway 35, McCarty Lane as it runs from Hunter Road to Union Pacific Railroad, Yarrington Road and Harris Hill Road, both as they run adjacent to the Whisper Development, Posey Road and Old Bastrop Highway, both as they run adjacent to the Trace Development.**

All annexations are subject to notification, public hearings, and vote by City Council. The annexation schedule is as follows:

**Ordinance 1<sup>st</sup> Reading (Public Hearing):** October 2, 2024, at 6:00 p.m., City Council Chambers, City Hall, 630 E. Hopkins St., San Marcos. (This hearing is a hybrid of virtual and in-person meeting.)

**Ordinance 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading:** **Updated - November 6, 2024**, at 6:00 p.m., City Council Chambers, City Hall, 630 E. Hopkins St., San Marcos. (This hearing is a hybrid of virtual and in-person meeting.)

The City Council of the City of San Marcos, Texas, will hold a public hearing via hybrid meeting at **6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 2, 2024**, to consider the above request.
