RESOLUTION NO. 2015- R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS APPROVING REVISED MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR COMMERCIAL AERONAUTICAL ACTIVITIES AT THE SAN MARCOS REGIONAL AIRPORT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS:

- 1. The San Marcos Regional Airport ("Airport") is operated by the City as an Enterprise Fund and the City desires to make the Airport available for commercial aeronautical activity.
- 2. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) recommends the use of Minimum Standards for Commercial Aeronautical Activities ("Minimum Standards") as the threshold entry requirements for a person or business entity to engage in commercial aeronautical service or activity for the benefit of the public at the Airport.
- 3. The use and implementation of the Minimum Standards minimizes the potential for violation of federal obligations at federally obligated airports, and the FAA encourages periodic review and publishing of Minimum Standards.
- 4. The current Minimum Standards were last updated on March 18, 2008 by Resolution No. 2008-41R.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

- **PART 1.** The City Council approves the revised Minimum Standards for Commercial Aeronautical Activities at the San Marcos Regional Airport as attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- **PART 2.** This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
