## **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-19**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS AMENDING THE PREFERRED SCENARIO MAP OF THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FROM "CONSERVATION/CLUSTER" TO "COMMERCIAL/EMPLOYMENT LOW" FOR APPROXIMATELY 199.49 ACRES OF LAND ON THE WESTERN SIDE OF FRANCIS HARRIS LANE; INCLUDING PROCEDURAL PROVISIONS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

## **RECITALS:**

- 1. On March 25, 2025, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of San Marcos held a public hearing regarding a request to amend the Preferred Scenario Map of the City's Comprehensive Plan to change the designation from "Conservation/Cluster" to "Commercial/Employment Low" for approximately 199.49 acres of land generally located on the western side of Francis Harris Lane.
- **2.** Subsequent to the public hearing on that date, the Planning and Zoning Commission considered the request and voted 8-1 to recommend denial of the request, PSA-25-01, to the City Council.
- **3.** The City Council held public hearings on June 3, 2025, and July 1, 2025, regarding the request.
- **4.** All requirements of San Marcos Development Code pertaining to Preferred Scenario Map amendments have been met.
- **5.** The City Council hereby finds and determines that the adoption of the following ordinance is in the interest of the public health, morals, welfare and safety.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

- **SECTION 1.** The Preferred Scenario Map of the City's Comprehensive Plan is amended to change the designation from "Conservation/Cluster" to "Commercial/Employment Low" for approximately 199.49 acres of land generally located on the western side of Francis Harris Lane.
- **SECTION 2.** If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this ordinance will continue in force if they can be given effect without the invalid portion.
- **SECTION 3.** All ordinances and resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.
