## Notification of Proposed Annexation by the City of San Marcos - AN-22-05 (Centerpoint Commons)

Dear Public Entity Representative:

Under Local Government Code Chapter 43, cities are required to notify certain public entities of all proposed annexations. The San Marcos City Council is considering the following annexations that may affect your jurisdiction:

Annexation of a 2.57 acre +/- acre tract of land out of the Edward Burleson Survey, Abstract 63, in San Marcos, Hays County, Texas, generally located on Centerpoint Rd approximately 340' northwest of the intersection between Centerpoint Rd and Gregson's Bend.

All annexations are subject to notification, public hearings, and vote by City Council. The annexation schedule is as follows:

**Ordinance 1**st **Reading (Public Hearing):** February 1, 2022 at 6pm, City Council Chambers, City Hall, 630 E. Hopkins St, San Marcos. (This hearing is a hybrid of virtual and in-person meeting)

**Ordinance 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading:** February 15, 2022, at 6pm City Council Chambers, City Hall, 630 E. Hopkins St, San Marcos. (Hybrid of virtual and in-person meeting)

The City Council of the City of San Marcos, Texas, will hold a public hearing via hybrid meeting at **6:00 p.m.** on **Tuesday**, **February 1**, **2022**, to consider the above request.
