# Typical Life Cycle of a project



- Simple Project = \$200K \$1M
  - $\circ$  3 4 Year
- Complex Project = \$1M \$10M
  - $\circ$  5 7 Years
- Very Complex Project = \$10M +
  - o 8-10 Years

#### **Important Notes:**

- Last Year Is For Construction
- We program "best case scenario"
- As challenges arise, construction funding is delayed until the project is ready

#### Not Seeking Input

- Budget Amount
- Balancing workload
- Staff will shift a project out to balance the workload
- Be aware that for a project to move up; something equivalent must move out
