SPIN E-Scooter East of IH-35 Pilot Program Update

Background

- May 7th, 2024, City Council approved the SPIN e-scooter East of IH-35 expansion pilot program.
 - Expanding the SPIN service zone along Aquarena Springs and Uhland Dr. East of IH-35.
 - Extending service hours to 24/7, an increase from the previous schedule of 5 AM to 12 AM.
 - Objective: Increase ridership by 3-5% while maintaining the current safety incident rate.
- July 1, 2024, SPIN implemented the East of IH-35 expansion program
- April 1, 2025, provide update on this pilot program and request expanding the program to an additional zone East of IH-35



SPIN Scooter Performance Results

July 2024 – February 2025 Ridership Summary:

- 1,487 rides occurred in the new East of IH-35 service zone.
- 4,528 rides occurred during the new service times, 12:00 AM and 5:00 AM.
- Rides in the East of IH-35 service zone accounted for **4.1%** of total ridership.
- Late-night rides (12:00 AM 5:00 AM) made up 8.6% of total ridership.
 - Implemented the SPIN Safe Start feature, an in-app feature designed to discourage people from riding under the influence.
- Combined, rides East of IH-35 and during late-night hours represented **12.7%** of all trips.



Safe Start Feature



An in-app checkpoint, Safe Start is **designed to discourage** people from riding under the
influence.

During late night hours, riders attempting to unlock an e-scooter are asked to verify that they can safely ride by correctly entering a keyword into the app.

Those who are unable to type the keyword correctly are encouraged to choose an alternative method of transportation, such as a taxi or ride-hailing service.



SPIN Annual Ridership Data

Year	Total Rides

^{*} SPIN has reported a decline in annual ridership due to the following factors:

- 1. Nationwide increase in personal micromobility device ownership
- 2. 50% reduction in rides categorized as "joy rides"



Current Safety Incidents and Review

- SPIN has reported 0 incidents during the pilot period
- The San Marcos Police Department (SMPD) has reported 0 incidents during the pilot period. SMPD has reviewed the new service zone plan and agrees with staff's recommendation to geofence the route under IH-35 to sidewalks only.
- The San Marcos Fire Department (SMFD) has reported 0 incidents during the pilot period. SMFD has reviewed the new service zone plan and agrees with staff's recommendation to geofence the route under IH-35 to sidewalks only.
- Reached out to Christus Santa Rosa Hospital and information regarding electric scooter incidents is pending




Recommended additional East of IH-35 zone

 - Sturgeon Drive




Current SPIN Scooter Service Zone






Current East of IH-35 Pilot Program Service Zone



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


Map of Recommended Additional East of IH-35 Zone

Example Deployment Zones











- \$0 cost program, no City funds required
- Economic benefit (COSM receives \$0.20 per ride)
- Increase utilization in micro mobility
- Alleviate traffic congestion by reducing the number of vehicles on the road



SPIN Program Benefits, Cont.

- Provide an additional transportation option for 3rd shift workers, students, and other community members
- Provide an equitable form of transportation (lower cost alternative to owning a car)
- Reduces carbon footprint and vehicle emissions
- Provide multimodal transportation options in an underserved area

Staff Recommendation

- Approval to incorporate the East of IH-35 pilot program into SPIN's permanent service zone.
- Approval for the expansion of the SPIN E-Scooter program to the newly proposed zone East of IH-35
