

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-168R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS ADOPTING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) ACTION PLAN THAT PROVIDES FOR THE ALLOCATION OF \$727,486.00 OF CDBG ENTITLEMENT FUNDS FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2022-2023; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ACT AS THE OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CITY IN MATTERS RELATED TO THE CDBG PROGRAM AND ACTION PLAN; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

PART 1. The allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) entitlement funds in the amount of \$727,486.00 of CDBG entitlement funds for Program Year 2022-2023 as set forth in Exhibit A, is approved.

PART 2. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to act as the official representative of the City in matters related to the CDBG Program and Action Plan.

PART 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.


