

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018- R**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT PROPOSAL TO THE NATIONAL FISH AND WILDLIFE FOUNDATION FIVE STAR AND URBAN WATERS RESTORATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 TO BE APPLIED TOWARD PROJECTS THAT WILL ENSURE CLEAN WATER FLOW FROM SESSOM CREEK TO THE SAN MARCOS RIVER; APPROVING MATCHING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF THE GRANT REQUEST; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:**

**PART 1.** The submission of a proposal to the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation Five Star and Urban Waters Restoration Grant Program for a grant in an amount up to \$30,000.00 for projects to ensure the clean flow of water from Sessom Creek to the San Marcos River is hereby authorized.

**PART 2.** The commitment and expenditure of matching funds (including in-kind contributions) from the City in the amount of \$30,000.00 is hereby authorized.

**PART 3.** The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents as necessary to accept and implement the grant, if awarded.

**PART 4.** This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
