Notification of Proposed Annexation by the City of San Marcos

Dear Public Entity Representative:

Under Local Government Code Chapter 43, cities are required to notify certain public entities of all proposed annexations. The San Marcos City Council is considering the following annexations that may affect your jurisdiction:

Annexation of a 136.912-acre tract of land located at 900 Francis Harris Ln, generally located one mile south of the Francis Harris Ln and S Old Bastrop Hwy intersection.

All annexations are subject to notification, public hearings, and vote by City Council. The annexation schedule is as follows:

Ordinance 1st Reading (Public Hearing): July 5, 2022, at 6pm

Ordinance 2nd Reading: August 2, 2022, at 6pm

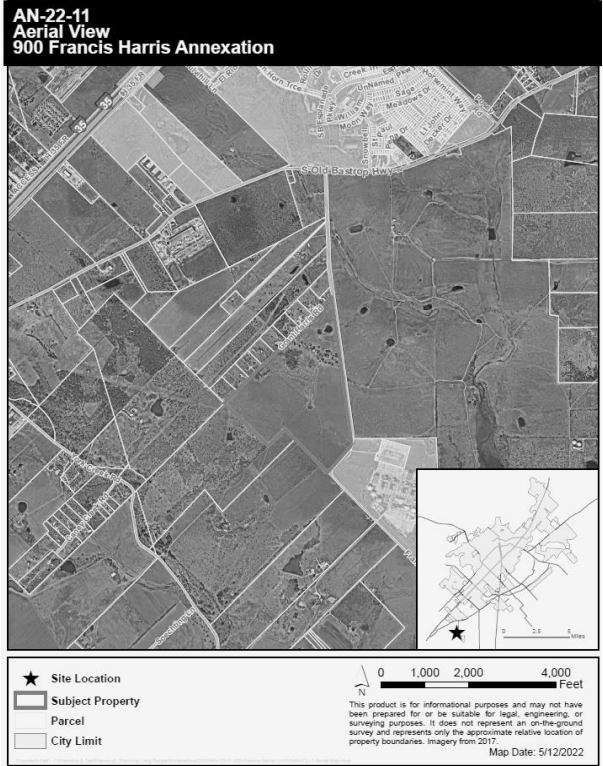
