Pg. 20 Add acknowledgement of Cape's Dam adjacent to the Plan Area boundary (see below for language)

Cape's Dam is a historical feature located adjacent to the Plan Area boundary at the edge of Cape's Camp Regional Park. The dam itself was constructed in 1867 to power a water-operated mill and served the local economy until 1942 (add endnote reference for Texas Historical Commission). The park surrounding Cape's Dam was closed to the public in 2015.

The San Marcos City Council has discussed the future of the dam at multiple meetings with considerations to the public safety, environmental conservation, historic preservation, and recreation. The City of San Marcos and Hays County entered into an interlocal agreement/memorandum of understanding in 2021 to collaborate on the proposed future of Cape's Dam (add endnote reference to Memorandum of Understanding).

- Pg. 96 Incorporate endnote references from the abovementioned Cape's Dam acknowledgment.
- Pg. 113 Add a zoning map to Existing Conditions Report to provide additional context for the Plan Area.
- Pg. 134 Change founding date of Southwest Texas State Normal School from 1903 to 1899.
