Total Containment Trap

The Total Containment Trap™ (TCT) provides complete ballistic coverage making it ideal for fixed firing lines and tactical training ranges. The TCT requires minimal maintenance and is equipped with the most efficient lead collection system available, keeping shooters, employees, and the environment safe.

Previous City Council actions:



- On September 19, 2023, the City Council approved Ordinance 2023-61(b), approving the Fiscal Year 2024 Capital Improvement Program. This included \$800,000 for the bullet trap.
- 2. On February 6, 2024, the City Council received a Staff presentation regarding approved FY24 CIP Projects and related funding; including proposed issuance of debt 2024 Certificates of Obligation Issuance.
- 3. On February 20, 2024, the City Council approved Resolution #2024-22R, authorizing proceeding with the issuance of Certificates of Obligation and directing the publication of Notice of Intention to issue the certificates. The Council authorized \$800,000 for the Total Containment Trap (Bullet Trap).
