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Capital Improvements Program


- Long-range plan and schedule for capital projects and system assets
 - Identifies workload for Departments
 - Identifies funding needs for City
- Identifies options for financing
- Planning Tool
 - Year 1 is only year approved in budget
 - Years 2-10 placeholders for planning purposes

Projects in year 1 are evaluated for:

- Project Readiness
- Staff Work Load
- City Ability to Fund The Project

Funding CIP Projects


- How do we fund CIP Projects?

 - Certificates of Obligation (CO) Council Approved (Majority)
 - General Obligation (GO) Voter Approved
 - Cash
 - Impact Fees
 - Grant Funding
 - Sale of city assets (not typical)



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


Categorized expenses by City

Fund	FY 2026
General	\$11.2M
Storm*	\$6.8M
Water/Wastewater**	\$86.9M
Electric	\$10M
Total	<u>+</u> \$115M

*Any costs above \$2M-5M will need to be supplemented by the General Fund **\$70M will be mostly funded by Developer Agreement
