

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-27

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS APPOINTING WILLIAM HENRY AS THE PRESIDING MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE FOR THE SAN MARCOS MUNICIPAL COURT OF RECORD TO FILL THE VACANCY ENDING OCTOBER 31, 2026 AND CONTINUING FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM THEREAFTER; INCLUDING PROCEDURAL PROVISIONS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. William Henry is hereby appointed as presiding judge of the San Marcos Municipal Court of Record to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of the previous judge for the remainder of the term of office of the previous judge that expires on October 31, 2026.

SECTION 2. William Henry is hereby appointed as presiding judge of the San Marcos Municipal Court of Record for a two-year term beginning November 1, 2026.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption on second reading.
