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Overview of the Economy



- The Federal Open Market Committee made a 50-basis point cut in September setting the federal funds rate at 4.75% to 5.00%
- The Committee is trying to reduce inflation to a rate of 2 percent over time
- Inflation in September 2024
 - Consumer Price Index: 2.4%, less food and energy: 3.3%
- Unemployment as of September 2024 (Unadjusted)
 - San Marcos: 3.8%
 - Texas: 4.1%
 - US: 3.9%
