Dear Tammy and Mike,

As you know, in August 2020, the City of San Marcos allocated \$105,530 in CDBG-CV funding to Hays County to be used for increased or improved COVID-19 testing. Of federal funds, CDBG must be spent as a last resort, and it is our understanding that the federal government has provided funding and supplies sufficient to cover testing needs without using the CDBG-CV funding.

After some discussions between City and County staff without identifying an alternative program through the County, it seems best to reallocate this funding away from the County to a new program that meets the CDBG-CV requirements. This letter is to provide official notification of our intent to make this recommendation to the City Council at a Council meeting within the next couple of months.

We value our continued partnership in other programs and look forward to working with you on other possibilities in the future.
