

224-160 On-Call Subsurface Utility Exploration Services – Scope of Services & Responsibilities

The successful Respondent will submit their proposal for both of the categories listed below. The City will consider the award of a five-year Master Agreement of On-Call Services based on the firm's competence and ability to perform the work on a per project basis either through its own forces or through the use of project teams that include sub-consultants. Each Agreement awarded will be negotiated and will be awarded based on the final approved scope of work. Dependent upon the funding source involved, the City may include additional terms that are required by the funding source. The successful respondent(s) will have a thorough understanding of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") guidelines and regulations for compliance, as well as all cross-cutting regulations required for the CDBG-DR program. In addition, the successful respondent will be cognizant of all other external requirements for each of the program components, including but not limited to Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA"), Federal Highway Administration ("FHWA") and other federal and state agency requirements.

Services may include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. SUBSURFACE UTILITY EXPLORATION:

- a) Vacuum Exploring – Level A;
- b) Utility Locating – Level B;
- c) Surveying – Level C; and
- d) Records Research – Level D
