- Consider approval of Ordinance 2025-42, on the second of two readings, appointing Jeffrey D. Weatherford as Associate Municipal Court Judge for the San Marcos Municipal Court of Record for a term of two years; and declaring an effective date.
- 2. Consider approval of Ordinance 2025-43, on the second of two readings, amending Chapter 46 of the San Marcos City Code by adding a new Article 4 to formally recognize and codify a tenant's right to organize; providing penalties for violation of the article; providing a savings clause; providing for the repeal of any conflicting provisions; and declaring an effective date.
- 3. Consider Resolution 2025-195R, approval of approving contract with Locus Technologies, through General Services Administration (GSA) Cooperative

Purchasing Program, for software to manage all laboratory certification requirements to meet the National Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program (NELAP) not to exceed \$139,142.00 for the first year and a recurring annual amount of \$69,142.00, subject to an inflationary increase of five percent annually, to automatically renew for a cumulative maximum contract term of 10 years; authorizing the City Manager, or her designee, to execute the contract on behalf of the city; and declaring an effective date.

- 4. Consider approval of Resolution 2025-196R, approving a purchase of an AT40GW backyard bucket truck, necessary for maintenance and construction projects, from Altec Industries, Inc., through a Sourcewell Purchasing Cooperative Contract, in the amount of \$174,451.00; authorizing the City Manager, or her designee, to execute the documents necessary for the purchase on behalf of the city; and declaring an effective date.
- 5. Consider approval of Resolution 2025-197R, approving a contract for the purchase of parts and supplies from ACT Pipe and Supply, Inc., through the Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative, for the Centerpoint Road Waterline Project in the amount of \$300,000.00; authorizing the City Manager, or her designee, to execute the contract on behalf of the city; and declaring an effective date.
- **6.** Consider approval of Resolution 2025-198R, approving up to four annual renewals of the current one-year contract with Troy Scott Najar, doing business as Evergreen Southwest, to provide the Micro-Solve chemical product which is applied to the City's sanitary sewer collection system to prevent the buildup of fats, oils, and grease, in the estimated amount of \$82,500.00 per year for an estimated total contract amount of up to \$412,500.00; authorizing the City Manager, or her designee, to execute any such renewals on behalf of the city; and declaring an effective date.
- 7. Consider approval of Resolution 2025-199R, approving the renewal of an agreement with Madden Media LLC, for search engine marketing in the annual amount of \$61,000.00, and up to three one-year renewals for a maximum of five years in the amount of \$244,000.00; authorizing the City Manager, or her designee, to execute the renewals on behalf of the city; and declaring an effective date.
- 8. Consider approval of Resolution 2025-200R, approving the renewal of an agreement with Madden Media, LLC, to promote tourism with Social Media and CTV Digital Marketing Campaigns in the annual amount of \$89,000.00, and up to three one-year renewals for a maximum of five years in the amount of \$356,000.00; authorizing the City Manager, or her designee, to execute the renewal on behalf of the city; and declaring an effective date.
