Re: Request for Amendment to An Agreement between the City of San Marcos, Texas, and Centro Cultural Hispano de San Marcos, for a CDBG Funded Program: Making Centro More Accessible and Energy Efficient Through Renovation

Ladies and Gentlemen:

As you are aware, Centro Cultural Hispano de San Marcos (Centro) has struggled to begin work on the CDBG articulated in the above-referenced Agreement. A "perfect storm" of a national pandemic, a change in administrative leadership, and supply-chain shortages resulting in rapid price increases has frustrated Centro's desire to move forward with the Grant. Additionally, a recent resolution by the San Marcos Independent School District Board of Trustees, conveying the former Southside School property to Centro, and associated confusion over the property's ownership, have further complicated Centro's administration of the Grant.

Due to these facts, and because of changing priorities and pricing, the Centro Cultural Hispano de San Marcos Board of Directors has voted to request the following, attached amendment to the Scope of Work (Appendix C, attached) and Budget (Appendix D, attached) included in the above-referenced Agreement. The Board believes this amendment will more accurately reflect Centro's current facility needs and allow for a more expeditious completion of the Grant's Scope of Work, while keeping with the original spirit of the Grant.

Appendix C: Detailed Scope of Work

Update HVAC System

- Replace six (6) Trane (or compatible, equal-or-better) 5-Ton rooftop units on existing curbs.
- Replace two (2) Trane (or compatible, equal-or-better) 10-Ton rooftop units on existing curbs.
- Install eight (8) rooftop units on existing curbs.
- Reinforce/Replace and seal outside ducts, as needed.
- Hail guards, new thermostats, and fresh air dampers included.
- Dispose of all removed equipment and debris in an approved facility in accordance with all local, state, and federal regulations
- Contractor to pay all costs of licensing, fees, permits, inspections, insurance, on-site supervision, and all other costs of work.

Replace Existing Roof

- Remove debris from roof area.
- Install a mechanically fastened ½" expanded polystyrene (EPS) insulation cover board over existing roof.
- Furnish and mechanically fasten a white, 50 mil single-ply membrane roofing system fabricated of a weft inserted, low-shrink, anti-wicking polyester fabric, and has a thermoplastic coating material laminated to both sides as manufactured by Duro-Last Roofing, Inc. (or compatible, equal-or-better).
- Install prefabricated flashings around all curbs, deck penetrations, and drains in accordance with membrane manufacturer's specifications.
- Install 24 ga prefinished facia bar with Kynar-coated (or compatible, equal-or-better) metal cover at roof perimeter. Cover color to be chosen by building owner.
- Install walk pads on serviceable side of AC units.
- Include 20-year warranty on roof and workmanship.
- Dispose of all debris in an approved facility in accordance with all local, state, and federal regulations.
- Contractor to pay all costs of licensing, fees, permits, inspections, insurance, on-site supervision, and all other costs of work.



Unexpended funds may be reallocated to a different line item in the above budget for use by the Subrecipient upon written concurrence from the City, without a formal amendment to this Agreement.

Soft costs, including program administration by Subrecipient administrative or management staff must be tracked by the hour on forms provided by the City. Eligible project administration salary and benefit costs are limited to time spent working directly on this project.
