Purpose



- Consider approval of an amendment to the contract with Flock Group, Inc. for additional equipment and software for the Police Department's license plate recognition technology in the amount of \$124,068.49 for the first year with the option to renew for three one-year extensions.
- This item will add 19 cameras to the contract for a cost of \$77,000, bringing the total contract amount to \$124,068.49. The grant will cover 80%, or \$61,600, of the \$77,000. The General Fund will cover the remaining \$15,400.

Flock history



- On April 19, 2022, the Council approved a resolution approving an agreement with Flock Group, Inc, for License Plate Reader (LPR) cameras/software.
- On December 29, 2023, Staff entered into a revised contract with an initial 2-year term, with 3 successive renewals terms of 1 year each (Contract 224-065).

- On February 24, 2024, Council approved a multiple use agreement with TXDOT for the installation of LPR cameras along state right-of-ways.
- On June 4, 2024, Council authorized a grant with the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority (MVCPA) for (10) cameras.

Flock history



- On August 20, 2024, Council authorized another grant with MVCPA for (9) cameras.
- On December 3, 2024, Council approved a revised Resolution for the grant with MVCPA for the (9) cameras originally approved on August 20, 2024.

- On April 1, 2025, Council postponed a Flock contract amendment.
- On May 20, 2025, Council authorized two grant applications with the MVCPA for the continued funding of (19) LPR cameras, with a required 20% match.



Council direction requested

 The Police Department seeks a contract amendment that will cost \$15,400 (our 20% grant match). The remaining expenses will be covered by two grants.
