

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-19R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS APPOINTING A MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO THE CENTRAL TEXAS CLEAN AIR COALITION FOR THE 2026-2027 TERM; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS:

- 1.** The Central Texas Clean Air Coalition, herein after known as the "Clean Air Coalition" members are organizations that support the regional efforts to improve and protect air quality in the Austin-Round Rock-San Marcos Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA).
- 2.** General members of the Clean Air Coalition shall be local governments or Independent School Districts within the Austin-Round Rock-San Marcos MSA that have ratified the current clean air plan, committing to implementing selected emission reduction measures.
- 3.** Each general member must appoint one elected official from their governing body to serve on the Clean Air Coalition.
- 4.** The appointed elected official will participate in the Clean Air Coalition representing the City of San Marcos in accordance with the coalition bylaws.
- 5.** The City shall provide written notification to the CAPCOG staff liaison of the appointed Clean Air Coalition representative.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

PART 1. _____ is hereby appointed as the City's representative to the Clean Air Coalition for the term beginning January 2026 and set to expire on December 31, 2027.

PART 2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
