I. Call To Order

With a quorum present, the special meeting of the San Marcos City Council was called to order by Mayor Hughson at 6:03 p.m. Monday, November 15, 2021. This meeting was held in-person and online.

II. Roll Call

1. Consider approval of Ordinance 2021-90R, canvassing returns and declaring results of the General Election, held on November 2, 2021, for the purpose of electing City Council Member, Place Five and City Council Member, Place Six, and to submit proposed amendments to the City Charter to the voters; declaring an emergency creating the need to adopt this Ordinance with only one reading; and providing an effective date.

A motion was made by Council Member Baker, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Scott, to approve Ordinance 2021-90, on one reading. The motion carried by the following vote:

Mayor Hughson opened the floor to nominations for the Mayor Pro Tem position.

Council Member Garza nominated Council Member Scott to serve as the Mayor Pro Tem. Council Member Baker nominated himself to serve as Mayor Pro Tem.

For Council Member Baker: Council Member Baker

Council Member Scott was elected Mayor Pro Tem.

Mayor Pro Tem Scott nominated Council Member Garza to serve as Deputy Mayor Pro Tem. Council Member Gleason nominated himself to serve as Deputy Mayor Pro Tem.
