I received a notice by mail in regard to a zoning change request Case no ZC-21-17. In reviewing the request for a zoning change to HC (heavy commercial) along with the corresponding applicable city code, I noticed that truck stops were included in that zoning classification. It was my understanding that the site was to be a convenience store with fuel sales, not a truck stop. If there are no heavy truck fueling or parking areas we have no reservations or objections in regard to a zoning change to HC zoning.
