## Notification of Proposed Annexation by the City of San Marcos

Dear Public Entity Representative:

Under Local Government Code Chapter 43, cities are required to notify certain public entities of all proposed annexations. The San Marcos City Council is considering the following annexations that may affect your jurisdiction:

Annexation of a 159.467-acres out of the Joel Miner Survey, Abstract 321, the William Hemphill Survey, Abstract 221, and the Thomas G McGehee Survey, Abstract 11 generally located at Harris Hill Road and Opportunity Blvd and the 2900 Blk of Yarrington Road.

All annexations are subject to notification, public hearings, and vote by City Council. The annexation schedule is as follows:

**Ordinance 1<sup>st</sup> Reading (Public Hearing):** July 5, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., City Council Chambers, City Hall, 630 E Hopkins St, San Marcos. (This hearing is a hybrid of virtual and in-person meeting.)

Ordinance 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading: August 2, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. (Hybrid of virtual and in-person meeting.)

The City Council of the City of San Marcos, Texas will conduct a public hearing via hybrid, in-person / virtual meeting at **6:00** p.m. on Tuesday, July 5, 2022, to consider the above request.
