Parking fee-in-lieu



Fee-in-lieu Amounts

Community	One Time Fee	Annual Fee	
Oak Bluffs, MA	-	\$100 - \$50 per space	
Davis, CA	Downtown: \$4,000/ space All other Districts: \$8,000		
Coconut Grove, FL	\$10,000/ space	\$50/ month	
Palmetto, FL	\$13,600/ space		
Lake Forest, IL	\$22,000/ space		
Jackson, WY	\$8,500/ up to 5 spaces \$17,000/ 6 or more		
Santa Monica, Ca	\$20,000/ space		
Bend, OR	\$510/ space		
Kirkland, WA	\$6,000 / space		



Fee-in-lieu Amounts

Questionnaire Results (4 responses): Results and input varied significantly.

- What should the Fee-in-lieu offset?
 - Split between using fee to offset additional parking and alternative transportation modes
- How much should the fee be?
 - Split between a one time fee and recurring fee
- Additional Comments?
 - Important for smaller developments that didn't have the room onsite and where people may choose not to bring a vehicle
 - Fee-in-lieu is tied directly to the market demand for parking and should be utilized with the goal of reducing demand.

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Fee-in-lieu Amounts

Staff Recommendation:

One time fee: \$10,000/ Space;

Annual fee: \$75/ year/ space;

Revisit fee and program on an annual basis
