I witnessed Wonder World visitors wandering onto my property before the perimeter was secured with a fence. I have concerns that consuming alcohol will cause individuals to trespass, and possibly increase crime.

As a pediatrician, I am disturbed by the idea of selling alcohol where elementary school age children enjoy field trips. I am troubled about the safety of combining alcohol and a tower over 100 feet high. I am also apprehensive about the preservation of the natural cave.

I implore you to consider my plea to deny Wonder World's request to sell beer and wine. I dread the noise and pollution will increase, and the safety matters unsettle me.
