AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS AMENDING THE TRAFFIC REGISTER MAINTAINED UNDER SECTION 82.067 OF THE CITY CODE TO ESTABLISH A TWO-HOUR PARKING RESTRICTION FROM 8:00 AM TO 5:00 PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF ACORN STREET FROM NORTH LBJ DRIVE TO CHESTNUT STREET AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 82.160 OF THE CITY CODE; AND INCLUDING PROCEDURAL PROVISIONS.

## **<u>RECITALS</u>**:

**1.** Section 82.160 of the San Marcos City Code allows the placement of signs on public streets or in a public area giving notice that parking is limited to a specified time.

2. The designation of a two-hour parking zone Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on the south side of Acorn Street from North LBJ Drive to Chestnut Street is in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare.

## **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS**:

**SECTION 1.** A two-hour parking zone to be effective from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday on the south side of Acorn Street from North LBJ Drive to Chestnut Street as depicted on the map attached as Exhibit A is hereby established.

**SECTION 2.** The Traffic Register maintained under section 82.067 of the San Marcos City Code is amended to reflect the two-hour parking designation established under Section 1.

**SECTION 3.** If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this ordinance will continue in force if they can be given effect without the invalid portion.

**SECTION 4.** All ordinances and resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be in effect upon adoption on second reading.

**PASSED AND APPROVED** on first reading on November 21, 2017.
