A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS, APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO. 2 TO THE RIVER RIDGE TO LOOP 82 UTILITY RELOCATION PROJECT IN ORDER TO FACILITATE THE NECESSARY ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES REQUIRED BECAUSE OF THE PRESENCE OF LPSTS (LEAKING PETROLEUM STORAGE TANKS) IN THE VICINITY OF THE PROJECT AND INCREASING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE PROJECT TO \$70,671.12; RATIFYING THE CITY'S EXECUTION OF THE CHANGE ORDER AND INCREASE IN DOLLAR AMOUNT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS:

- 1. The Engineering & CIP Department personnel discovered the presence of documented LPSTs (Leaking Petroleum Storage Tanks) in the vicinity of the River Ridge to Loop 82 Utility Relocation Project.
- **2.** Due to the discovery of the LPSTs, TxDOT requires that the City install ground water monitoring wells in the area as part of the project.
 - 3. The dollar amount of this change order requires that it be approved by City Council.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

- **PART 1.** Change Order No. 2; the installation of ground water monitoring wells as part of the River Ridge to Loop 82 Utility Relocation Project in the amount of \$20,547.20 is approved.
 - **PART 2.** Change Order No. 2's increase in total project price to \$70,671.12 is ratified.
- **PART 4.** This Resolution will be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage.
