## **ORDINANCE NO. 2018-**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS AMENDING THE CITY'S 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO ALLOCATE \$314,000 OF SALES TAX REVENUES IN THE GENERAL FUND TO THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS IN THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUAL AMOUNTS: HOMEBUYER INCENTIVE PROGRAM (\$60,000); IT SECURITY REVIEW PROJECT (\$25,000), FACILITY SECURITY PROJECT (\$100,000), CIS SOFTWARE LICENSE **UPGRADE (\$129,000); ADDING FULL TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS IN** THE FINANCE, ENGINEERING, AND PLANNING DEPARTMENTS TO BE PAID WITH HUD DISASTER RECOVERY FUNDS; AMENDING THE STAFFING TABLE FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT DUE TO OF POSITIONS PERFORMING RECLASSIFICATION THE FIRE MARSHAL FUNCTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

## **RECITALS:**

In accordance with Section 8.16 of the City Charter, the City Council declares that a public necessity exists that requires an amendment to the City's 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Budget.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.** The City Budget Ordinance for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year is amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit A.

**SECTION 2.** These revisions will be incorporated into the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year City Budget.

**SECTION 3.** If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this ordinance will continue in force if they can be given effect without the invalid portion.

**SECTION 4.** All ordinances and resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance will take effect immediately after its passage, approval and adoption on second reading.
