

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-43

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS APPOINTING A PRESIDING JUDGE, AND AT LEAST ONE ASSOCIATE JUDGE, FOR THE SAN MARCOS MUNICIPAL COURT OF RECORD, EACH FOR TERMS OF TWO YEARS; DECLARING THIS ORDINANCE AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO ENABLE ADOPTION IN ONLY ONE READING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Dallari Landry is hereby appointed as presiding judge of the San Marcos Municipal Court of Record for a two year term.

SECTION 2. John Burke is hereby appointed as associate judge(s) of the San Marcos Municipal Court of Record for a two year term.

SECTION 3. Any presently sitting judges of the San Marcos Municipal Court of Record not expressly appointed or reappointed by this ordinance are not reappointed.

SECTION 4. The terms of office for the appointments under Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on November 1, 2018.

SECTION 5. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the provisions of the City Charter requiring that ordinances be presented at two separate meetings is hereby waived and, this ordinance will take effect upon its adoption.
