ORDINANCE NO. 2018-____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS AMENDING THE CITY'S 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO CREATE THE PARKING MANAGEMENT FUND, ALLOW EXPENDITURES IN THE SUM OF \$134,411 FROM THE PARKING MANAGEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE FOR **OPERATING** EXPENDITURES FOR THE PARKING MANAGEMENT PROGRAM, AND ADD A FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT POSITION TITLED PARKING MANAGER TO THE PARKING MANAGEMENT FUND; AMENDING THE STAFFING TABLE FOR THE CITY TO REFLECT THE ADDITION OF ONE FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS:

In accordance with Section 8.16 of the City Charter, the City Council declares that a public necessity exists that requires an amendment to the City's 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Budget Ordinance for the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year is amended to add a Parking Management Fund, expenditures in the amount of \$134,411 for operations of the Parking Management Program, and add a full-time employment position titled Parking Manager as shown in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. This amendment will be incorporated into the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year City Budget and amends the staffing table to reflect the addition of one full-time employee in the Community Services Department.

SECTION 3. If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this ordinance will continue in force if they can be given effect without the invalid portion.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance will take effect immediately after its passage, approval and adoption on second reading.
