

**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-\_\_\_\_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS AMENDING THE CITY'S 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO CREATE THE PARKING MANAGEMENT FUND, ALLOW EXPENDITURES IN THE SUM OF \$87,258 FROM THE PARKING MANAGEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE FOR OPERATING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PARKING MANAGEMENT PROGRAM, AND ADD ONE FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT POSITION TITLED PARKING MANAGER IN THE PARKING MANAGEMENT FUND; AMENDING THE CITY'S STAFFING TABLE TO REFLECT THE ADDITION OF ONE FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**RECITALS:**

In accordance with Section 8.16 of the City Charter, the City Council declares that a public necessity exists that requires an amendment to the City's 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Budget Ordinance for the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year is amended to create the parking management fund and add a full-time employment position titled Parking Manager as shown in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

**SECTION 2.** This amendment will be incorporated into the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year City Budget and amends the staffing table to reflect the addition of one full-time employee in the Community Services Department.

**SECTION 3.** If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, or paragraph of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this ordinance will continue in force if they can be given effect without the invalid portion.

**SECTION 4.** All ordinances and resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance will take effect immediately after its passage, approval and adoption on second reading.

**PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED** on second reading on December 12, 2018.
