
The Service Contract for Water Treatment Facilities Operation and Asset Management between the City of San Marcos, Texas and the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority, dated September 20, 2005 (the Service Contract or Contract), was extended in 2015, but is now set to expire on December 16, 2020. GBRA proposes that the Service Contract be extended for an additional five (5) years to expire on December 16, 2025, as contemplated in Section 3.2 of the Contract. We propose that the terms of the Service Contract, as amended to date, remain in full force and effect during the 2020-2025 Extension Period.

If the City is in agreement, we would ask that a duly authorized representative of the City sign below and return to me. If the City does not wish to extend the Service Contract, we ask that the City notify GBRA at least 90 days prior to the current expiration date of the Contract by sending notice as provided in the Contract.
