## 2021-2022 Action Plan Process

May 4	Public hearing regarding community needs	
May 23-June 18	Application process is open	
May 27	Stakeholder Workshop, Applicant Workshop	
June 28-July 29	30 day public comment period	
July 6	Council update on all applications received	
August 3*	Council approval of 2021-2022 slate of projects	

<sup>\*</sup>Final Decision must be made on this date due to HUD deadline



## **Overall Requirements**

Of the \$766,842 received from HUD + \$56,933 from prior years

70% of \$823,415 must benefit people with low/mod incomes = **\$576,391** (Low/mod = less than 80% of Area Median Income)

No more than 15% of \$766,842 for public services = **\$115,026** 

No more than 20% of \$766,842 on Admin or Planning = **\$153,368** 



## **Application Evaluation Criteria**

- Activity Need and Justification: 25 Points top priorities for San Marcos (Consolidated Plan)
- 2. Impact and Cost Effectiveness: 30 Points overhead, leveraging other resources
- 3. Implementation: 25 Points focus on measurable outcomes
- 4. Past Performance or Letters of Reference: 20 Points strong record of managing funds, or potential to do so
