Title: Consider approval of Resolution 2015-92R approving an Economic Development Incentive Agreement, pursuant to Section 1.4.4.1 of the Land Development Code ("LDC"), between the City of San Marcos and Willy Jack, L.L.C. that grants a waiver of the requirement under Section 4.3.4.2 of the Land Development Code that a restaurant in the Central Business Area must be in operation for at least six months before it may sell beer and wine for on-premises consumption; and at least 12 months before it may sell mixed beverages for on-premises consumption in connection with a proposed restaurant and bar at 242 N. LBJ Drive; authorizing the City Manager to execute said agreement on behalf of the City contingent upon the issuance of a Conditional Use Permit for on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages by the Planning and Zoning Commission; and declaring an effective date.
