**BACKGROUND:**

Rate modeling for the Resource Recovery Utility indicates the need for a 3% rates adjustment to both the single family rate for fiscal year 2018. This rate adjustment will fund expenses for the Resource Recovery services provided, educational and public outreach, and administration of the program.

The single family rate includes a 65-gal trash cart, 96-gal recycling cart, 96-gal green waste cart, Green Guy Recycling

services, Household Hazardous Waste drop off, brush drop off, downtown trash/recycling public container service, City special events trash, and community clean ups. There is an extra \$3 per month for a 96-gal trash cart if requested instead of a 65-gal trash cart.

The multifamily recycling service includes on-site recycling, Green Guy Recycling services, Household Hazardous Waste drop off, downtown trash/recycling public container service, City special events trash, and community clean ups.
