This request is for a renewal of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for Japan Latino Restaurant. The Planning and Zoning Commission granted a three (3) year CUP renewal for the sale of beer and wine on April 14, 2015. The CUP will expire on April 14, 2018, and therefore, the owner has submitted an application for renewal.

The restaurant has 75 indoor seats and 30 off-street parking spaces. The hours of operation are from 11:30am - 10pm, Monday - Sunday. No live music or entertainment is provided. The applicant has indicated that there are no other proposed changes to the business or site.
