A joint workshop between the Planning and Zoning Commission and City Council was held in June 2019. At that workshop the Council and Commission provided direction to move forward with changes related to typos, scrivener's errors, graphical errors, and technical errors which Staff had identified and documented over the first year of the Code's use. The group also identified two policy related amendments that were approved by the Historic Preservation Commission and could be brought forward for consideration immediately. In addition, the 2019 Legislative Session has produced a number of House Bills that require amendments in order to meet State law. The proposed amendments included in this packet encompass those three types; 1) typos and technical errors, 2) policy related amendments that the group requested be expedited at the June 2019 workshop, and 3) amendments in response to enacted Bills from the 2019 Legislative Session.

Section 2.4.1.3 of the San Marcos Development Code requires the Planning & Zoning Commission to make a recommendation regarding the text amendment(s) to the City Council. Below is a summary of the process and key dates.

Development Code Amendments Process Summary

- City Council provides initial authorization to further consider or alternatively, rejects the proposal (11/6)
- Planning & Zoning Commission considers the amendments and recommends approval, approval with conditions, or denial of the text amendments (11/12)
- City Council holds a public hearing and first reading of ordinance (12/3)
- City Council holds second reading of ordinance (12/17)
