Background Information:

The City of San Marcos is requesting that the Hays County Tax Assessor bill and collect for the annual assessment associated with the Trace Public Improvement District. The County is willing to do the collection and will charge the following for their services. The fee for assessment and collections services furnished to the District shall be \$0.15 (15 cents) for each parcel on the District's assessment roll which lies within Hays County and \$0.85 (85 cents) for each parcel on the District's assessment roll which lies outside Hays County. All fees paid to the County will be paid by the Trace Public Improvement District. The number of parcels will change over time so the fee will vary from year to year but it will not cost the City of San Marcos anything.
