Background Information:

Pursuant to Chapter 791, Texas Government Code, the City may enter into an interlocal cooperation contract with North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) whereby the City may procure certain shared products or services through the NCTCOG contracts.

Through the interlocal agreement with NCTCOG, the City intends to utilize a contract with Gabriel Roeder Smith & Company, Irving, Texas for actuarial services for the City's benefits plan through the NCTCOG. The City is required by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GSAB) to perform these services for our benefits plan on a biennial basis. The contract itself for actuarial services is less than \$13,000 every two years.
