Background Information:

During heavy flooding that occurred in San Marcos during October 2015, the road leading to the San Marcos Surface Water Treatment Plant was damaged. The purpose of this project is to repair the culvert pipes crossing the creek and repair of the damaged pavement surface and erosion at the crossing. This project is approved for reimbursement by FEMA at 75% with City funding at 25%.

On May 2, 2019, the City received nine (9) bids for this project in accordance with Purchasing Policy and statutory requirements for competitive sealed bidding. Bids were evaluated by City staff and the City's third-party Engineer, Alan Plummer Associates, Inc. Staff and the City's Engineer recommends award to the lowest responsible responsive bidder, Westar Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$192,940.50
