- Council passed an Ordinance prohibiting “for profit” scooters - May 2020
 - Provided for scooter pilot program
 - Allowed private scooter use
- COVID-19 restrictions on bus carrying capacity lead University to explore an alternate option for student transportation needs
 - University began discussions with Spin - June 2020
 - City joined University in discussion on potential scooter pilot - July 2020
 - Agreements with Spin reached - August 2020
 - Scooter pilot begins - September 2020
- City, University, and Spin hold weekly meetings and monitor the scooter pilot - (Sept. - Present)
- Spin provided a summary of pilot results for the fall semester - January 2020
