JLBC 710 Investments, LLC, a Texas limited liability company (“JLBC”) entered into a Regional Wastewater Services and Facilities Cost Sharing Agreement with the City on May 14, 2024. Article VII, “Miscellaneous”, Section 5, “City Consent to Districts”, calls for City consent to the creation of this Municipal Utility District (“MUD”) within 60 days of the receipt of a petition, provided the petitioner meets the requirements of Section 54.016(a) of the Texas Water Code. City Utilities staff and the City Attorney’s office have determined that the requirements have been met in the Petition for Consent to the Creation of the Sedona MUD No. 1, submitted on June 14, 2024.
